The Recreation and Parks Department is currently taking registration for the following youth athletic programs:

- **YOUTH SOCCER** - ages 3-14. Registration is through Friday, August 12th, 2011. The registration fee is \$15 for Spring Lake residents and \$30 for non-residents. Birth certificate copy and fee are required at the time of registration.
- **YOUTH FOOTBALL** - ages 5-12. Registration is through Friday, August 5th. The registration fee is \$20 for Spring Lake residents and \$40 for non-residents. Birth certificate copy and fee are required at the time of registration.
- **YOUTH CHEERLEADING** - ages 5-12. Registration is through Friday, August 5th. The registration fee is \$15 for Spring Lake residents and \$30 for non-residents. Birth certificate copy and fee are required at the time of registration.
- **GIRLS YOUTH VOLLEYBALL** - ages 9-14. Registration through Friday, August 12th. The registration fee is \$15 for Spring Lake residents and \$30 for non-residents. Birth certificate copy and fee are required at the time of registration.
- **YOUTH TENNIS** - ages 7 & up. The lessons are \$20 per child. Each participant should bring a good amount of drinkable water and a tennis racquet (some racquets are available by the Recreation Department if the request is made in advance). Lessons begin Wed., Sept. 7th and are Wednesdays 6-7:30 pm and Saturdays 8-9:30 am. The lessons run for 6 weeks.

The Recreation and Parks Department will begin registration for the following youth athletic programs **October 3rd, 2011:**

- **YOUTH BASKETBALL** – ages 3-17. Registration will be through Friday, November 18, 2011. The registration fee is \$15 for Spring Lake residents and \$30 for non-residents. Birth certificate copy and fee are required at the time of registration.
