The three (3) day charette focusing on Main Street/downtown will be the beginning of an initiative Town leaders are formulating to redirect focus on projects and issues that have not received the due diligence they deserved.

With the help of staff and the resources available to us, we are working to create a Spring Lake that meets the needs of all its residents and visitors well past the year 2020.
